



The Eastern Education Foundation will be supporting the Arts Program (drama, music, literary and visual arts) within the district in the 2009/2010 school year. The *Eastern Education Foundation* has allocated a total of **\$40,000** in funding to support grant applications.

### **Funding Guidelines**

The following are the basic funding guidelines for the *Eastern Education Foundation*:

#### **Criteria:**

- Funding requests should clearly demonstrate enhanced student learning through the arts.
- Funding will be considered for new instruments, technology and other capital investments; new programs, visiting artists, supplies/resources, and costs related to performances and exhibits.

#### **Guidelines:**

- There are two funding deadlines: October 23, 2009 and **February 26, 2010**.
- Only one application per school per deadline.
- All applications must be signed by the school principal
- **Applications must be emailed and then faxed with signature to District Office.**
- Schools must complete the Internal Application fully in order to apply.
- No late applications will be accepted.
- Grants will be awarded to schools in October 2009 and March 2010.
- The maximum grant awarded will be \$1000.00.
- The Foundation will not allocate funding directly to individual students.
- All funding decisions of the Foundation are final.

#### **Eligibility:**

In order to be eligible to receive *Eastern Education Foundation* funding, your school must sign an Eastern Education Foundation funding agreement.

#### **Funding Principles**

The Foundation will fund Arts-related initiatives that demonstrate need and which impact on the greatest number of students within its school.
